Organization has no EHS accountability or basic policy in place.

Realize that EHS regulations must be followed

Assume responsibility for providing a detailed, comprehensible EHS policy

Understand that when an incident occurs, steps must be taken to rectify the issue

Organization has an EHS policy but typically reacts when an incident occurs rather than implementing preventative measures.
